



TRAFALGAR NIGHT DINNER 2017

The Naval Club's Trafalgar Night Dinner will be held in The Naval Club on Friday 20th October 2017. The Principal Guest will be Stephen Prince, Head of the Naval Historical Branch in the Ministry of Defence. He has previously been a Sir Robert Menzies Scholar at the Australian War memorial, a lecturer at Britannia Royal Naval College and a senior lecturer at the Joint Services Command and Staff College.

The cost of the dinner will be £78-50p per head, which will include all pre dinner drinks, a three course meal, coffee, two glasses of port and at least half a bottle of high quality wine. A cash bar will be available on completion of dinner. Please return the booking application form as soon as possible, but at the latest by Friday 13th October. The maximum number seated at the dinner this year in the Naval Club will be one hundred and five using both the Dining Room and the Cunliffe-Owen Room; with an audio/video link between the two floors for the speeches.
